Getting there

PARTICIPANTS INFORMATION

International participants will arrive at Amsterdam Airport Schiphol, or Rotterdam Airport.

Arriving at Schiphol Airport there is a train connection (50 minutes) to Delft Central Station. The train from Schiphol does not stop in Delft, one needs to change train in Leiden or Den Haag HS. The Schiphol railway station is located directly underneath the Central Arrival Hall. Tickets can be purchased from the vending machines located in the Arrival Hall close to the escalators to the train station.

From Rotterdam Airport an airport shuttle brings you in about 20 minutes to Rotterdam Central station. From Rotterdam Central Station it takes approximately 15 minutes by train to reach Delft Central Station. It is also possible to take a direct taxi from Rotterdam Airport to Delft. Venue

The workshop will be held at the Aula Conference Centre of Delft University of Technology, Delft, the Netherlands. Delft, a beautiful city with a historic city centre with old canals and ancient buildings, is more than 750 years old. The city owes its name to the word 'delving', digging the oldest canal, the Oude Delft. In 1246, Delft received its city franchise from the Dutch Earl Willem II. Delft flourished and new neighbourhoods were added. As early as 1355 the city reached the size it would remain until the 19th century.

Bus



Strippenkaart

To travel with public transport you need a ticket. The 'Strippen Card' is valid throughout the country for travelling on a bus, tram and metro. Every city or region has been divided into transportation zones with set tariffs. To travel one zone you have to pay two 'strips'. You pay an extra 'strip' for each subsequent zone. Within the same zone you may change within a time limit mentioned on the back of the card. You can buy a 'Strippen Card' with 15 strips $(+/- \ \ 6,80)$ or with 45 strips $(+/- \ \ 19,20)$. You can buy 'Strippen Cards' at railway stations, in post offices, department stores and tobacconists. You can also buy it on the tram or bus, but then the price is quite a bit higher.
